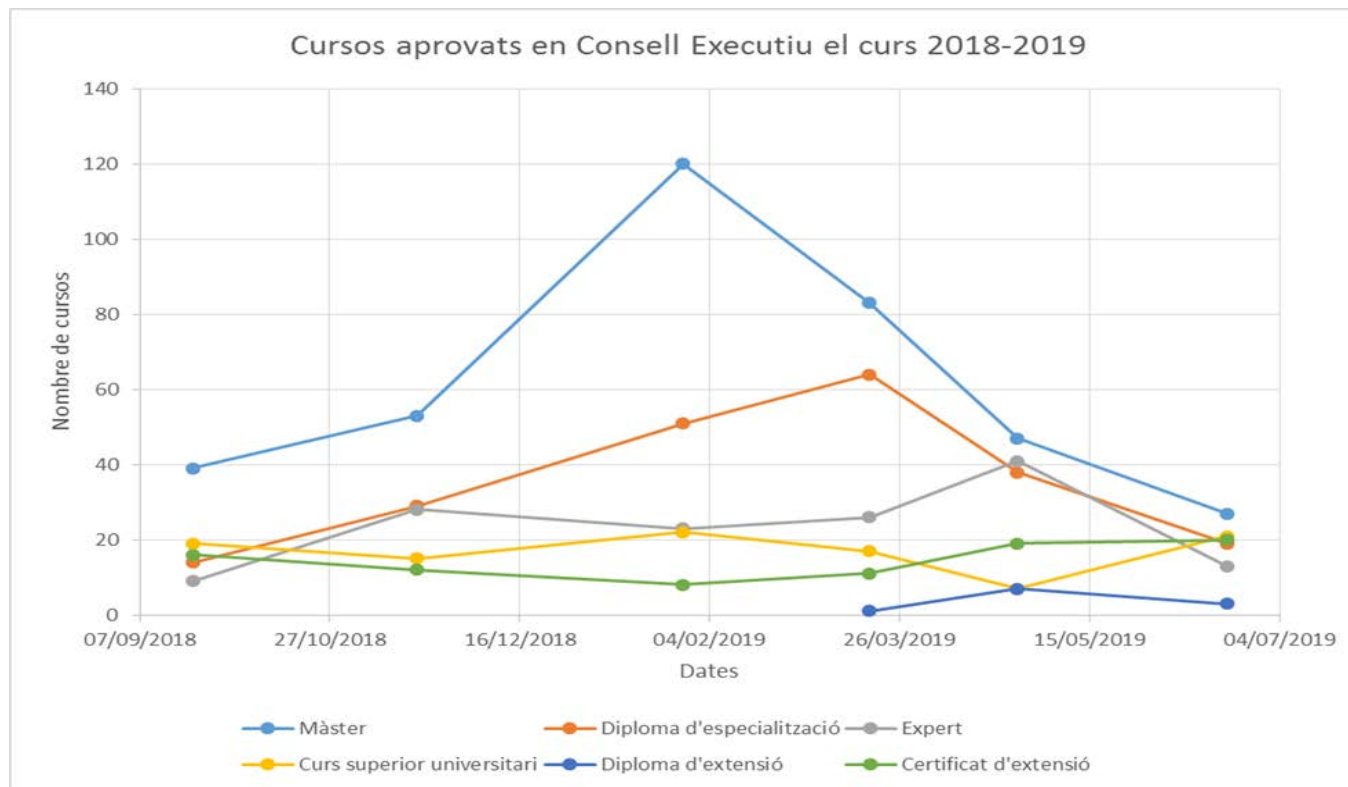




CONTINUING COURSES AT UB. EVOLUTION AND CURRENT SITUATION

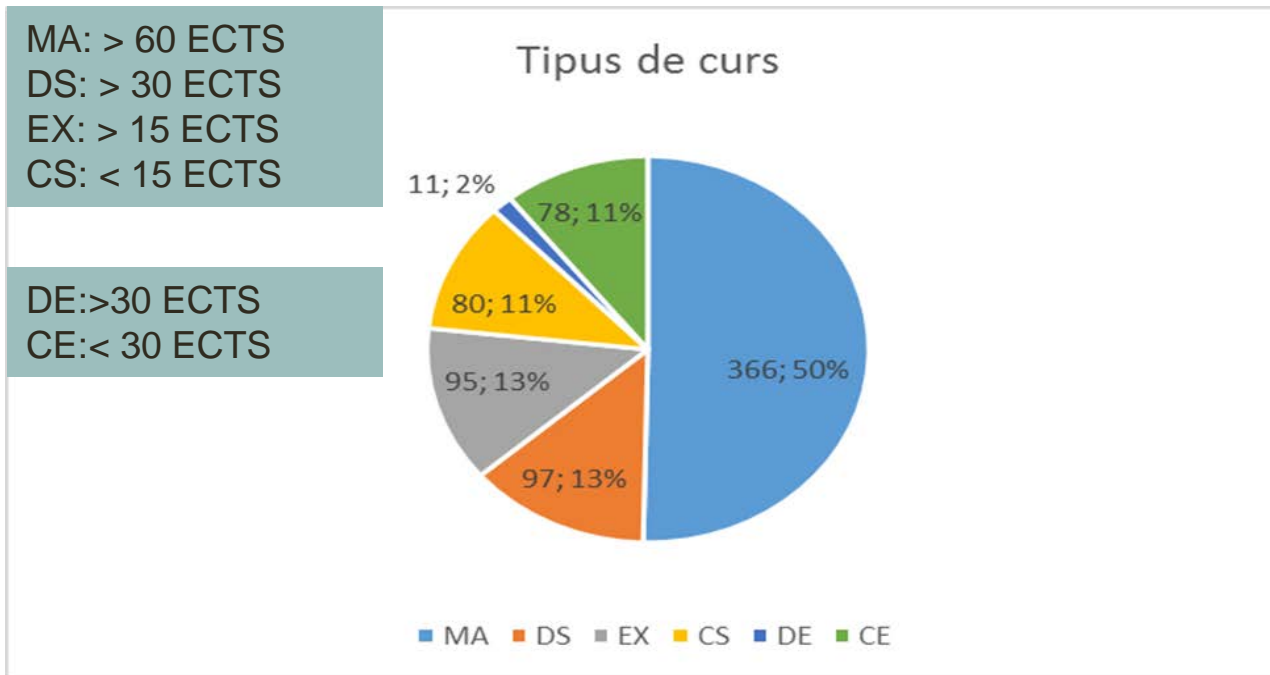

COURSES PASSED PER MEETINGS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE (POSTGRADUATE AGENCY)

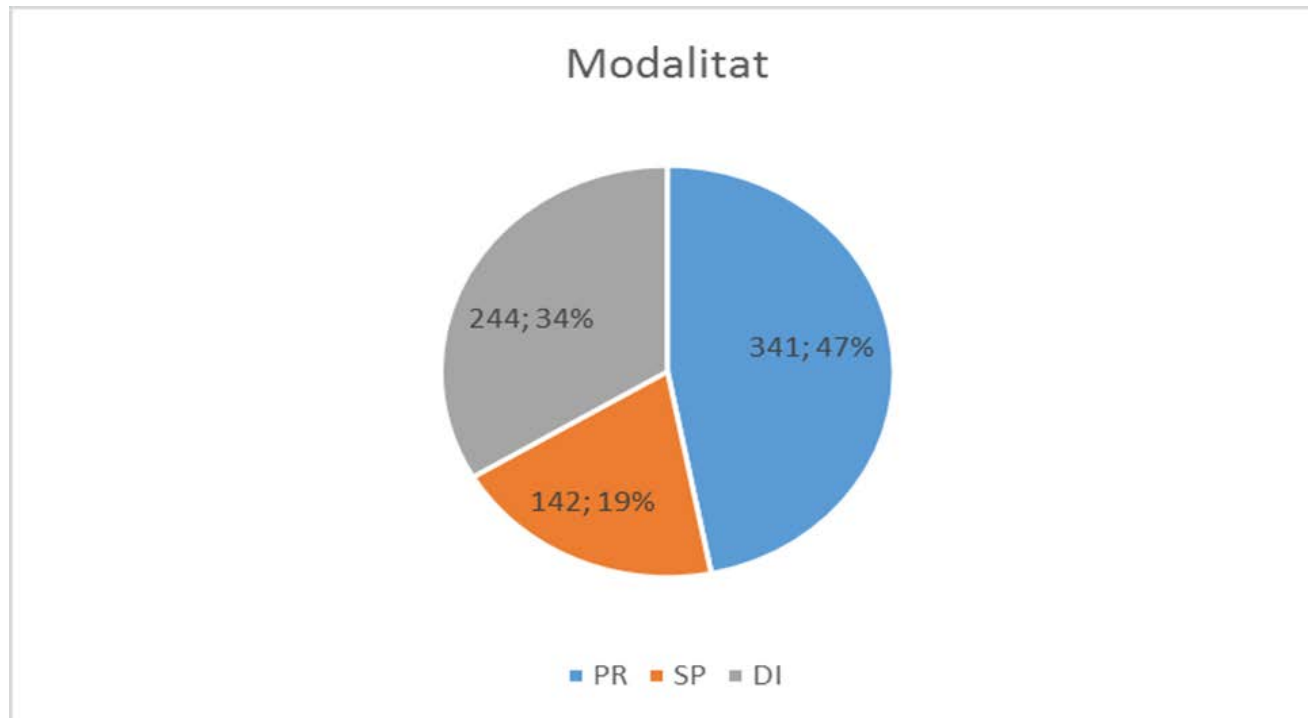


- 922 courses (163 are rooted to other courses) and 64 activities of short duration.
- Slight decrease (-0.1%) respect previous academic course.

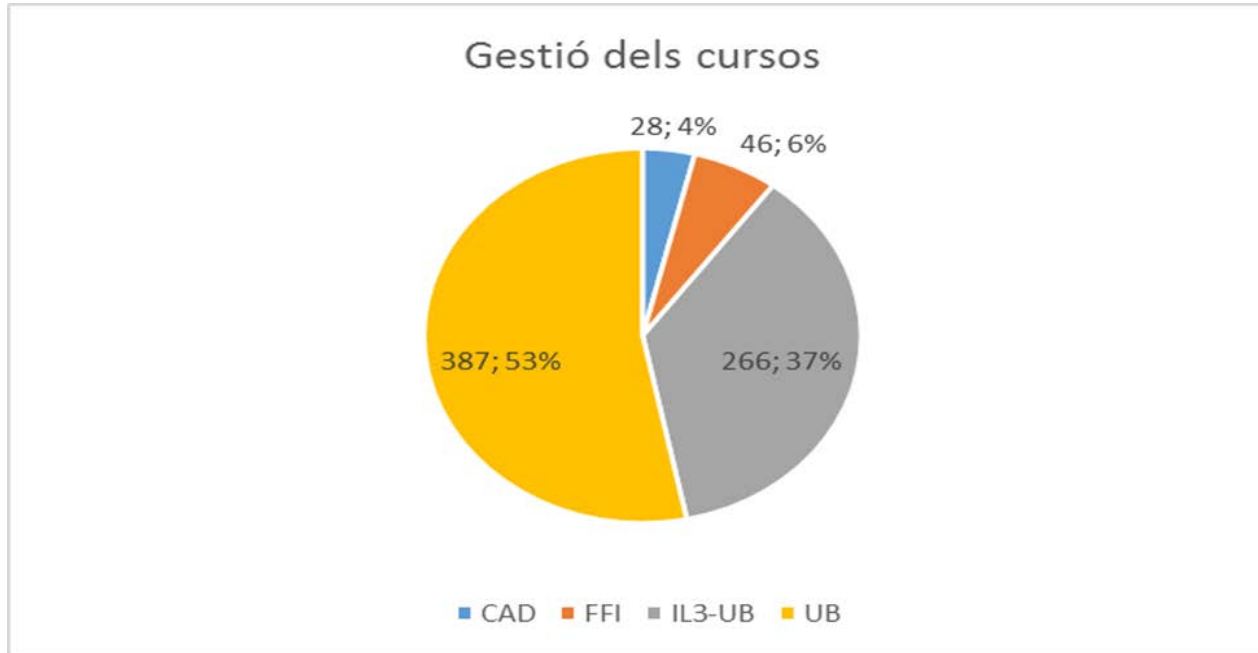
TYPES OF COURSES



- 87.8% of these courses allow students to obtain post degrees (50% are masters).
- 12.2% are courses which allow students to obtain a sort of diploma.

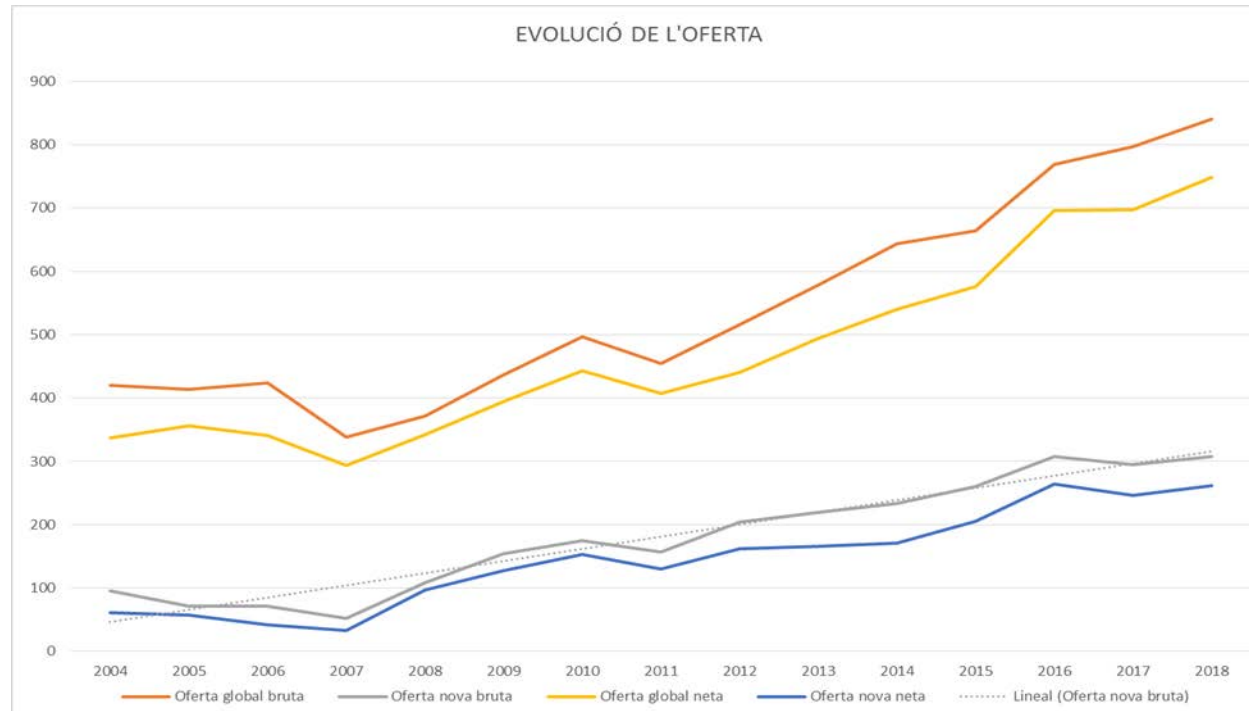


- 47%: face-to-face courses.
- 34%: courses on-line (increase of 2% respect the previous academic course).
- 19%: blended courses.



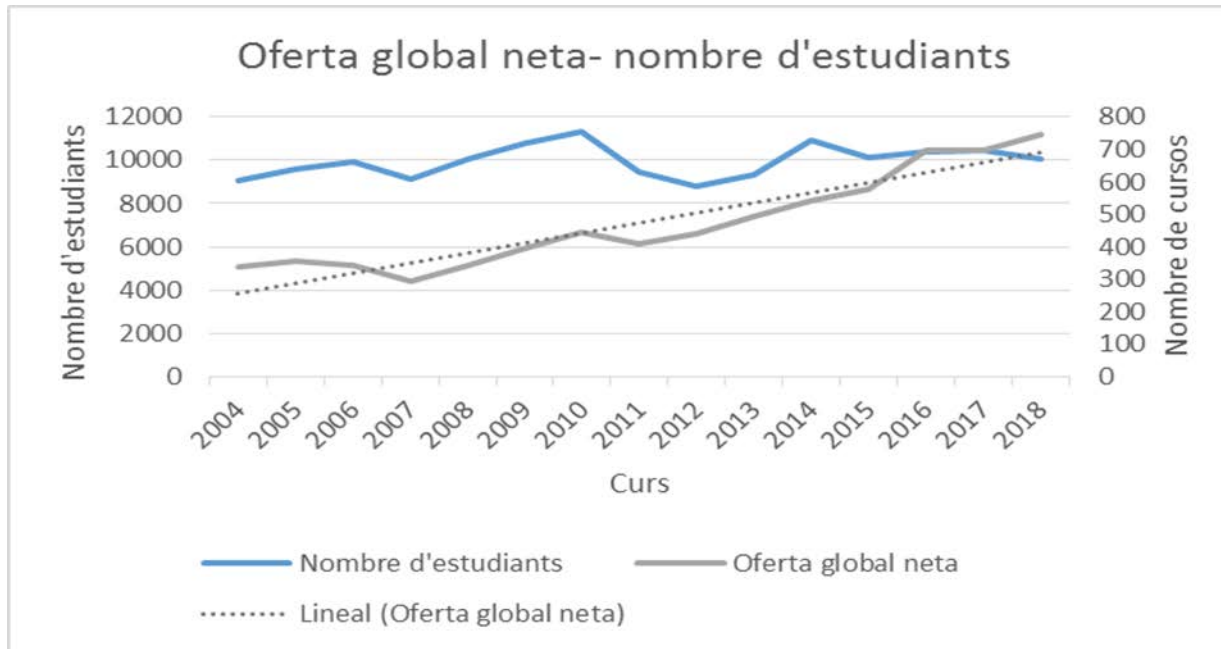
- 89.9% managed by UB faculties (53%) and IL3-UB (37%)

EVOLUTION OF THE ACADEMIC OFFERING AND OF THE ENROLLED STUDENTS (I)



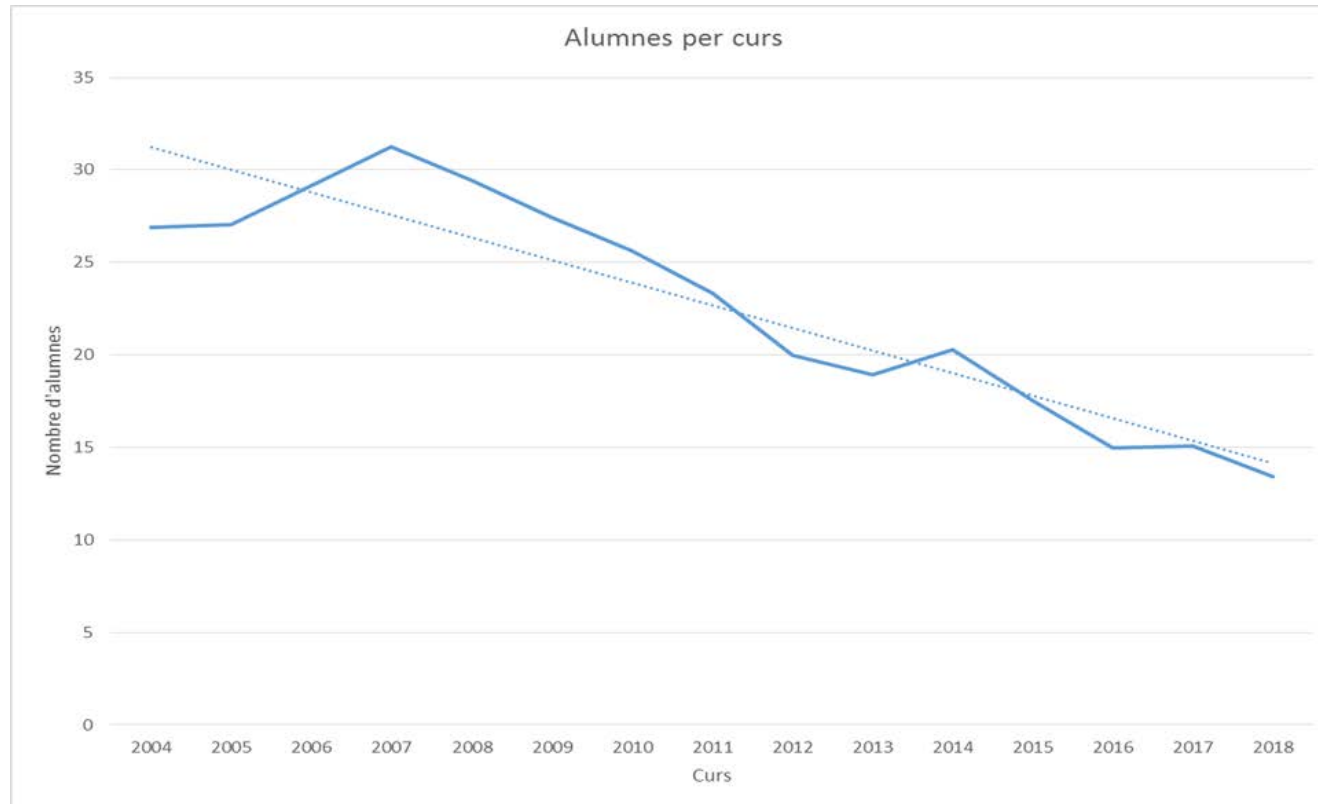
Since 2004, global academic offering has suffered a significant increase of 121.9%

EVOLUTION OF THE ACADEMIC OFFERING AND OF THE ENROLLED STUDENTS (II)



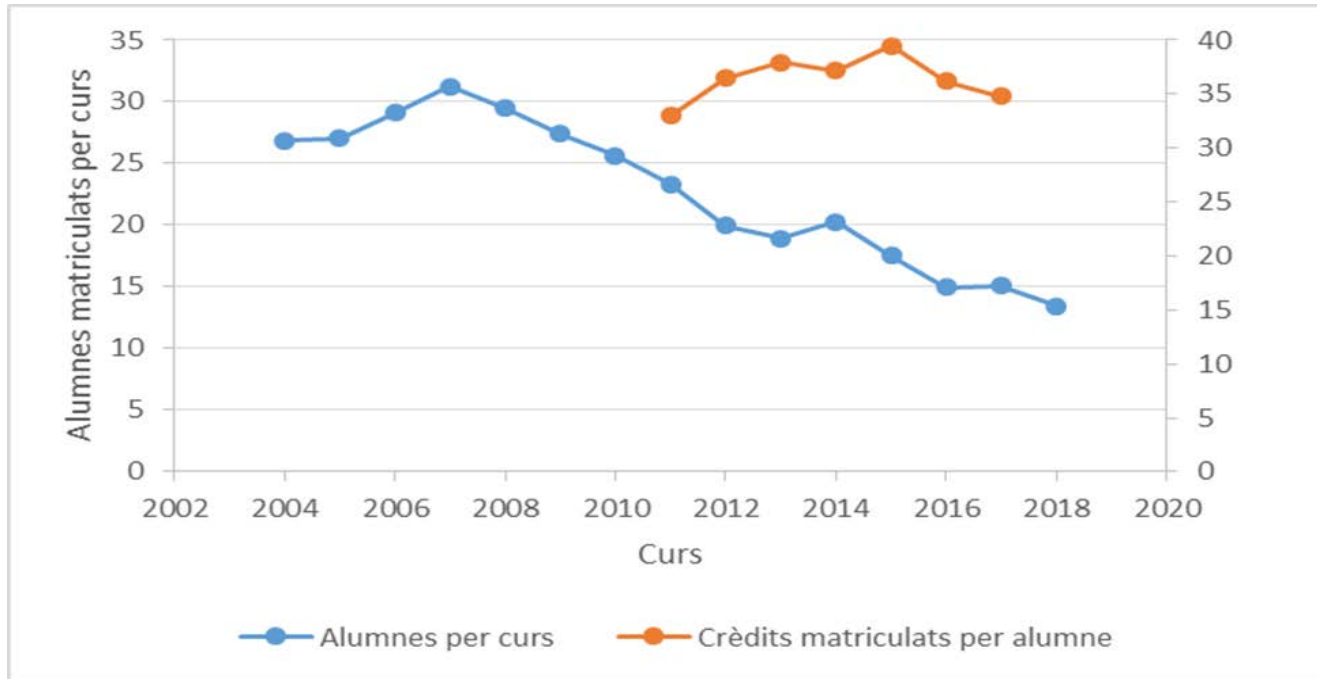
Since 2004, the number of enrolled students has suffered a non-significant increase of 10.9%.

EVOLUTION OF THE ACADEMIC OFFERING AND OF THE ENROLLED STUDENTS (III)



On average, the number of students per course has decreased from 27 in 2004 to 13 in 2018.

EVOLUTION OF THE ACADEMIC OFFERING AND OF THE ENROLLED STUDENTS (IV)



On average, the number of credits enrolled per student has not varied significantly in the period 2011-2018.
