The FCU network was created in 1971 and formed as an association in 2004. It gathers 91 members, including 100% of State-run French universities.



Its objectives



- ❖ To build a network between LLL departments in state-run universities and higher education institutions
- ❖ To nurture quality exchanges with the Ministry for Higher Education about LLL matters
- ❖ To act as a spokesperson for the FCU with
 - public entities in the field of employment and training
 - private entities (employers, funders)
 - at international level
- ❖ To promote the activities of its members
- ❖ To ensure a legal and information watch on LLL
- ❖ To support the departments with a specific FCU training plan for the staff of its members
- ❖ To exchange practices
